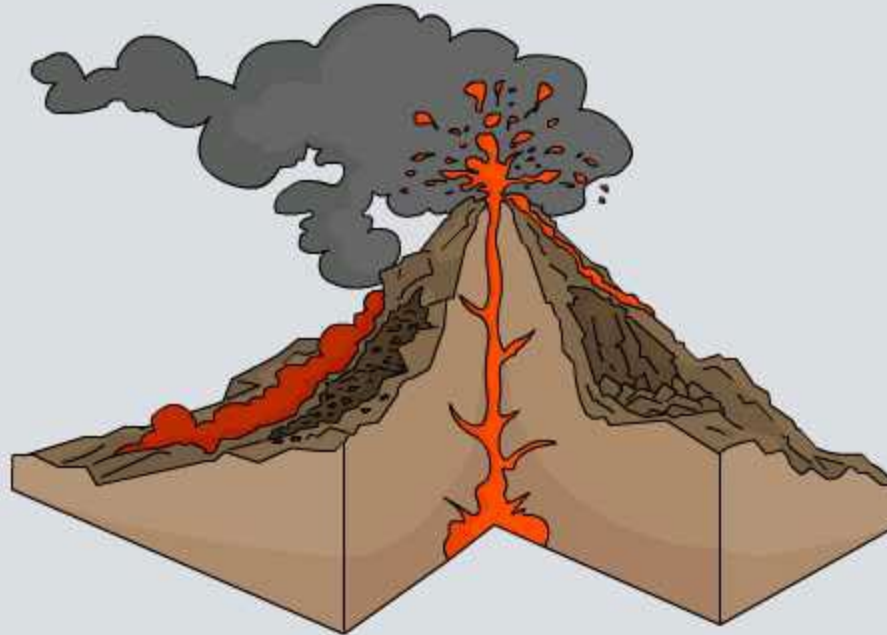
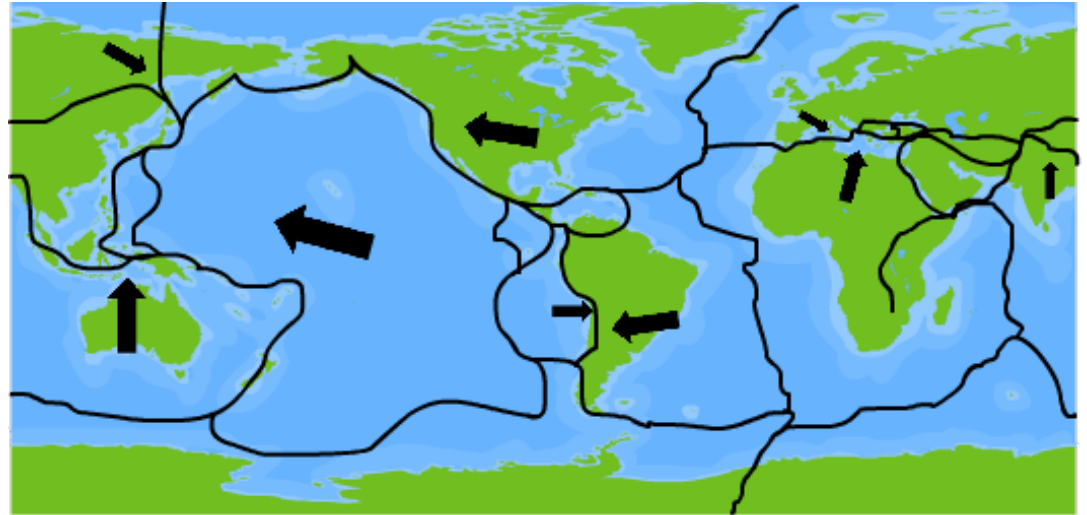


Plate Boundaries



The tectonic plates are moving in different directions.

The movements have different effects on the landscape of the Earth.



- Plates that are moving in opposite directions form a **divergent** boundary.
- Plates that move towards each other form either a **convergent** boundary or a **collision** boundary.
- Plates sliding by each other form a **transform** boundary.
